# 2. What is your vision for Ku-ring-gai?

Ku-ring-gai has the beauty of being around the Ku-ring-gai National park and tree lined streets. I'd like to see our environment supported. I'd like to see quality facilities like the upgrade of Marian Street Theatre.

Ku-ring-gai has very few activities for the young so some teenage activities and 20+ places to go and congregate would be great.

I'd like to see some vibrancy within town centres, the design of the town centres is limited and a fresh look at how we can have community feel with good facilities.

#### 4. The key issues faced by Ku-ring-gai are:

- 1. TOD developments
- 2. Lack of connection with State Government
- 3. Poor facilities
- 4. Town Centres are not cohesive or vibrant
- 5. Many empty shops that is an indication there's something wrong
- 6. There appears to be a problem with the Masterplan and placement of infrastructures eg NSFA want to go to North Turramurra but this takes away the community ownership of the area and the NSFA are only paying \$1 per year. There must be a better place to put this. How do I plan to address these issues?

As a new councillor, I will liaise with council staff and see what can be done to address.

### 5. How will you ensure community engagement and participation?

It helps to go to community events and be present. So many councillors don't even bother.

### 6. What do you consider are Key issues in your Ward?

1. Wahroonga Estate has not enough parking allocated so cars are parking on the streets and clogging up the area. Apartment blocks don't have enough allocated parking.

2. Renovation of Norman Griffiths oval has been an environmental issue with synthetic turf being allowed to go on there. Norman Griffiths oval revamp has been a terrible example of poor community engagement, lack of assessments with environment issues, seems to have been driven by sporting groups.

The community tried to tell council there was an issue by putting their court case together. They lost the court case but the environment testing afterwards showed the contamination with the Quarry Creek. This is a terrible ongoing power struggle that the sporting groups won and the community lost.

- 3. Speeding around Comenarra solar panel speed signs are needed to reduce cars speed.
- 4. Crime has increased in Comenarra cameras and surveillance is required.
- 5. Parking around Fox Valley Rd shops is taken by SAN visitors etc
- 6. West Pymble Philip Mall area up graade
